he Charterhouse has a remarkable history; from its foundation as a Carthusian Priory in 1371, to becoming a Tudor Mansion, Almshouse and School. The Charterhouse stands today as it has for centuries and remains the home of the Brothers of Charterhouse whose own history dates back to the 1611 origins of today's foundation.
