Who we are looking for:	 A friendly attitude and enthusiasm for gardening. Ability to work as a part of a team. Some experience in gardening. The Charterhouse is open to all. We welcome applications from people of all abilities, backgrounds and communities.
Commitment to you:	 As Garden Volunteer, you will have the opportunity to: Develop your gardening knowledge. Receive full training and support to fulfil the role. Work as a part of a team. Learn about the history of the Charterhouse and its gardens. Meet new people and take part in special activities organised for volunteers.
Why We Want You:	The Charterhouse has had a long and remarkable history from the mid- 14 th century to the present day, as a Carthusian monastery, Tudor mansion, Victorian school and almshouse. Our incredible site has also borne witness to key events such as the Black Death, Henry VIII's dissolution of the monasteries, the Civil War and Second World War. However, our fascinating story has been largely unknown. Until now. Since January 2017 we are open to the public with a brand-new museum, a learning centre and a newly-landscaped Charterhouse

	Square. We would like you to join us in this exciting project and help us maintain our extensive grounds and gardens for our visitors and members of the community.
